INTRODUCTION:

- I. THIS COMMANDMENT IS ABOUT GOD'S NAME AND HIS CHARACTER Yahweh-his covenant name (Lord which speaks of divinity—God of Israel).

II. POWER IN HIS NAME

- 1. Power to protect (Psalm 20:1).
- 2. Power to give victory (Psalm 20:5, 118:10,11, 12)
- 3. Power to bring fear to the enemies (Psalm 102:5).
- 4. Power to deliver the soul (Joel 2:32, Psalm 116:4)
- 5. Power to help the oppressed (Psalm 124:8)
- 6. Power whereby the righteous run into it and finds refuge (Proverbs 18:10).
- 7. Majesty in His name (Micah 5:4).
- 8. Power to save (Acts 2:21, Roman 10:13).
- 9. Power to heal (Acts 3:6, James 5:14).
- 10. Authority to be baptized (Matthew 28:18-20).
- 11. Power over demons and powers of darkness (Acts 16:18).
- 12. Power to be justified (I Corinthians 6:11).
- 13. Power on which every knee must bow (Philemon 2:10).
- 14. Power by which we inherit eternal life (I John 5:13).

III. SIN OF MISUSING HIS NAME

- A). Meaning of misuse—take in vain—waste, unreal, empty, frivolous, insincere. Blaspheme is na'ats in Hebrew to mean despise or insult.
- B). Punishment for misuse—we will be held accountable—Matthew 12:36, 37—by our speech, we will be judged.

"Speech is the sacred vehicle of the invisible soul, the most spiritual, non-material function of the body." Kent Hughes.

Vows, oaths and swearing—Are they Christian? Yes, we can, but don't be slow to do it. Ecclesiastes 5:1-7 talks about fulfilling our vows before God.

Jesus our Lord taught in Matthew 5:34-36 that we should not swear. Rather let your yes, be yes; and your no, no (Matthew 5:33-37)!

To break an oath is to dishonor God's name and it is so easy to fall into the trap of the evil one.

IV. WHAT ABOUT THE UNPARDONABLE SIN?

Matthew 12:22-32

- A). What is the unpardonable sin?—It is attributing to Beelzebub/satan what God the Holy Spirit did through Christ.
- B). Can we commit the unpardonable sin?
- C). Can one who has committed this sin be pardoned?

LESSONS TO LEARN AND TO OBEY:

If we truly know and love God, we will never misuse or abuse His name:

- 1. Don't Impress others by saying prophetically what God didn't say (Jeremiah 14:14-16, Ezekiel 13:6)
- 2. Don't use His name as a swear language e.g. Ananias and Sapphira used God's name to support their lie
- 3. Don't treat His Character and His word with contempt
- 4. Don't be distracted even by good intentions...1 Kings 13:18.
- 5. But honoring and exalting God's Name and His Word in our lives
