Adultery wrecks family, wrecks lives, wrecks marriage.

Insecure kids

One sin leads to another

A. Adultery--extra-marital affair (Exodus 20:14, Deuteronomy 5:18)

I Peter 5:8

Those who commit adultery lose effectiveness and many opportunities for life and ministry.

- B. Fornication--pre-marital affair (I Corinthians 6:18)
- C. Bestiality--affair with animals (Exodus 22:19, Leviticus 18:23, 20:15,16)

D. Homosexuality--affair with members of the same sex (Leviticus 18:22, Romans 1:26, 27, I Corinthians 6:9)

E. Incest--affair with members of own family (Leviticus 18:6-18)

F. Sexual Immorality in thoughts and in actions

I Corinthians 6:9, Hebrews 13:4 E.g. Frog in the hot bath Jeremiah 17:9

Adultery in the heart--Matthew 5:27, 28 Lust in the heart--Proverbs 6:25 Guard the heart--Proverbs 4:23 Punishment for Adultery--Leviticus 20:10
